<p>Slide and Jack Service</p> <p>Every 3-4 Months</p> <p>What you get:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Test slideouts for proper operation • Clean slide walls • Lubricate slide seals • Lubricate all slide components (as necessary) • Inspect applicable hydraulic lines • Ensure proper operation of control board • Clean all jacks, including foot pads <p>Why you need it: Exterior slide gaskets are rubber and will harden if not kept conditioned. On some systems, slide rails and gears need to be cleaned and lubricated regularly. Jacks also need to be serviced regularly to protect the seals and prevent debris from building up and working its way up into the jack assembly.</p>	<p>\$198.00</p>
